RCM REPORT – February 11, 2024

Good afternoon Trusted Servants, The NJRSC last met January 27, 2024 in Engishtown ,N J. There were 9 areas out of 12 present. The next NJRSC will be on 3/16/2024@ Emanuel Lutheran Church, 1-3 Kirkpatrick St. New Brunswick, NJ 08901.

Chair Report: He asked for a motion concerning to continue to have a conference if we have a problem with the wifi in future regional meetings. There was no motion from the floor.

Treasury : We have a working balance of \$21,062.81 plus \$6000 prudent reserve, \$300 mtg. list, \$2100 Insurance and \$1,333.34 for storage reserves.

RD REPORT : Some key info. from MARLCNA . NAWS has a main service office in Chatsworth, Calif., 2 branch offices in Brussels, Belgium and Tehran, Iran. They also have 2 distribution centers one in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada and the other in Bangalore,India. They mentioned that NAWS is unique corporation that does not make decisions based solely on profit. There will be an interim WSC in February,2025. There are currently 72,215 weekly mtgs. worldwide, not counting virtual mtgs. For virtual info. go to www.na.org/virtual. For virtual mtgs. Basics go to www.na.org/toolbox. They are asking you to register your room early for those going to the world convention by going to www.na.org/wcna . There are 9000 people already registered. Registration is \$175 which they will only break even. There will be no banquet this year. The dates are 8/29/24 to 9/1/24 . WCNA 38 will be streamed on audio only. Other discussions were local services, Area inventories and medically prescribed marijuana. The meaning of the term recovery versus or fellowship meaning of recovery. Also discussions on Lack of trusted servants. Disruptive and predatory behaviour in meetings. Making addicts on prescribed medication feel welcome and not judging those same addicts desire to stay clean. Service is a privilege not a right. You can go to www.na.org/idt for more follow up. 
